

Mooi Binnenveld is turning blue!

Mooi Binnenveld is full in bloom and turning blue. As the vegetation develops, the Soft rush and Compact rush are disappearing and species typical of Fen Meadows (Blauwgrasland) – Carnation sedge and Purple Moor Grass - are becoming more dominant. An astounding number of Marsh gentians and Devil's bit scabious are everywhere. There's much to see on a walk along the klompenpad through Mooi Binnenveld. To the East of the walkway there are clear patches of Carnation sedge among the Marsh gentians. Many other flowers can be seen from the walkway and the field margins – Common centaury, Devil's bit scabious, Brown Knapweed, Sneezewort, Milk parsley, Greater bird's-foot trefoil, Yellow rattle and much more. Time to go for a stroll!
